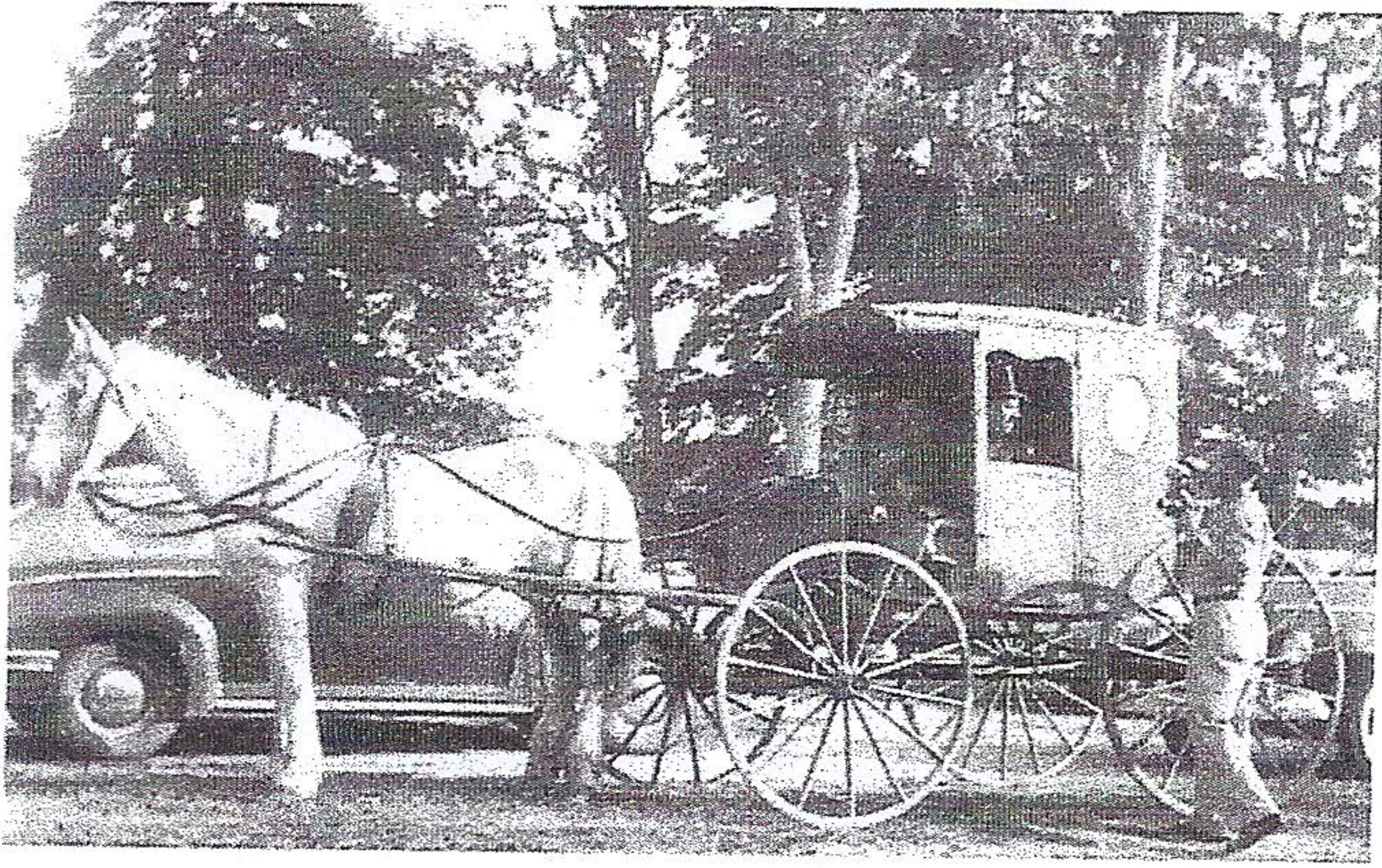

100 years old. The old stepping stone upon which church-goers dismounted from their horses for generations is located on the Commons near a tree from Alaska, planted when that state was admitted to the Union and secured by honorary club member U.S. Senator Margaret Chase Smith, a Harpswell summer resident on Sebascodegan Island.

In keeping with its interest in history, the Harpswell Garden Club established contact with the town's European namesake: Harpswell, England — a charming village in Lincolnshire noted in the Domesday Book of 1086. Residents of Harpswell, Maine had been aware of their old world roots for years, but in 1969 Miss Anne decided to visit the village in person and, with that trip, established the club's international outreach program.

Miss Anne wrote to Harpswell, England to reserve a hotel room and was answered by the village mayor, who invited her to stay in his home. Alerted by another club member, he also arranged a celebration of her birthday while she was there. As a gesture of friendship from the Garden Club, Miss Anne presented to the Harpswell parish church money to plant a rose garden. Later the club bestowed on the English church a wrought-iron flower stand, something
